We Have Grown! Summer Sizzle Keyboard Kamp 2011 is now offering **SIX** different groups as follows:

- i. Group A: ages 8 -10; piano grades 1- 3 conservatory **FULL!**
- ii. Group B: ages 11- 13; piano grades 1 - 3 conservatory
- iii. Group C: ages 10 – 13; piano grades 4 – 6 conservatory **FULL!**
- iv. Group D: ages 12 – 16; piano grades 5 – 7 conservatory (attending Summer Sizzle Keyboard Kamp for the first or second time)
- v. Group E: ages 12 – 16; piano grades 5 – 7 conservatory (attending Summer Sizzle Keyboard Kamp as a veteran) **AVAILABLE Summer Sizzle 2012**
- vi. Group F: ages 13 – 20; piano grades 7 to advanced conservatory

Students must apply for one of the assigned groups. Grading is approximate.

Groups which do not meet 70% registration minimums by March 15, 2011 are subject to: a) cancellation b) merging with other groups.

Registrations will be accepted on a 'first-come' basis. When a class has been filled, applicants may be placed on a waiting list in the event that space becomes available.

Children under 12 years of age (required for overnight campers/ recommended for day campers) must be accompanied by an adult.

Each group/student will participate in the following:

1. **Christopher Norton Master Class:** prepare a Christopher Norton solo of the participants choice (any level of preparation is welcome – make it fun and comfortable). This class will be hosted by Isaac Holbrook, a dynamic and inspiring young ma sponsored by the Novus Via group.
2. **Composers & Kids: New in 2011!** Summer Sizzle Keyboard Kamp and *Northern Lights* Canadian National Conservatory of Music is dedicated to promoting, supporting and inspiring Canadian music. During the 2011 Keyboard Kamp, students will have opportunity to perform and work with visiting Canadian composers. The *Composers & Kids* session will be hosted by a visiting composer whose works are representative of the age and grade level of the group. Students are strongly encouraged to perform a work by their host composer. Please direct inquiries regarding available repertoire to CNCM Office of the Registrar.

3. **Christopher Norton Improvisation Class** from *American Popular Piano Etudes*. **New in 2011!** Students registering before **March 1, 2011** will receive the required material/books by mail (Repertoire/CD/Improvisation Etudes) with instructions from Christopher, as part of their registration package. This class will also be hosted by Isaac Holbrook with webcam appearances from Christopher Norton.

Also New in 2011! Each group of students will receive one improvisation preparation/instruction session with **Tyler Seidenberg**, as well as one improvisation instruction session with the Norton Group.

4. **Personal Original Composition Class:** again in 2011, *Summer Sizzle Keyboard Kamp* is offering participants the opportunity to submit one of their own original compositions no later than April 15th, 2011. Each composition will be reviewed by a visiting Canadian composer prior to *Summer Sizzle*. During *Summer Sizzle* students will perform their original composition for their assigned group. Compositional techniques will be discussed as a whole with the group during this class. Please note that although the composition class is a group activity, the submission of an original composition is optional.

New in 2011! All submissions received by the deadline will be published in a *Summer Sizzle Student Collection* available at Summer Sizzle.

5. **Group Composition:** throughout the three days of *Summer Sizzle* each group will work directly with a visiting Canadian composer and create a group composition. This composition will be performed for parents, students and teachers during the final *Summer Sizzle* workshop. Please bring your ideas and other instruments. During *Summer Sizzle 2011*, each group will have the luxury of having their own private room throughout the event – instruments can easily be secured in these rooms.
