Students, teachers and studio groups are invited to submit ONE suggested title for the CNCM theme music.

'Name that Piece!' Challenge Guidelines:

1. Students, teachers or studio groups may submit ONE suggested title. Please include full name and age.
2. Participants will submit ONE suggested title to: cncmnamethatpiece@gmail.com
3. Participants should listen to the CNCM video theme music – both the introductory portion and the section which is heard after the performance video at:

4. Suggested titles must be submitted by **April 15th, 2022**.
5. Participants should consider the following when creating a title: originality; representation of the mood of piece; reflection of *Northern Lights* CNCM philosophy
6. The selected title of the CNCM video theme music will be announced by May 15th, 2022.
7. The participant whose title is selected will:
 - a. have a dedication appearing on the score
 - b. receive a copy of both the easy piano and intermediate arrangement of the CNCM video theme music

The *Northern Lights* Canadian National Conservatory of Music 'Name that Piece!' challenge is free for anyone to enter. Copies of the CNCM video theme music will be available for purchase in June of 2022.
